NSWRU CLUB ADMINISTRATORS' GUIDELINES

The NSWRU Administrators' guidelines will be used to underpin the RA Code of Conduct which can be found on their website at RAC of C or see a copy at Appendix A at the back of this document

By representing yourself in an honest manner, you will endeavour to uphold the following to the best of your ability:

- 1. Ensure that the club distributes the RA Code of Conduct and Conditions of Entry and that these are displayed at home games and made known to all participants.
- 2. Ensure your club trains its players, coaches and Ground Marshals in their responsibilities.
- 3. Monitor participant behaviour for any breaches of the RA Code of Conduct or Conditions of Entry and take appropriate action to stop and/or sanction such behaviour.
- 4. Display the example of expected behaviours through your own clubs behaviours, emphasising the importance of fair play.
- 5. Help coaches and officials highlight appropriate behaviour and skill development, and help to improve the standards of coaching and officiating.
- 6. Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from the game.
